Nazareth Academy High School, located at 4001 Grant Ave., is pleased to announce that it will be installing nine new Smart Boards in their classrooms for the next school year. The new Smart Boards are being installed over the summer thanks to the efforts of the Nazareth Academy High School Development staff and the Nazareth Academy Parents Association.

On March 28, Nazareth held its annual Blue and Gold Auction at their Midnight Masquerade event. With an initiative entitled “For the Girls” the school was able to secure direct donations for the Smart Boards of over \$18,000, an amount that is enough for the purchase and installation of five Smart Boards. The Nazareth Academy Parents Association had already pledged the donation of three Smart Boards and the school is receiving another thanks to a grant received by the school’s Italian Department.

Smart Boards are interactive white boards that allow teachers to incorporate technology in the classroom. The touch-sensitive display connects to your computer and digital projector to show your computer image. You can then control computer applications directly from the display, write notes in digital ink and save your work to share later.

“The addition of these Smart Boards will further boost what is already an outstanding learning environment,” Sister Mary Joan Jacobs, ED. D. said. “We appreciate the efforts of all the people who made the acquisition of our Smart Boards possible.”
