In the event of inclement weather, check the school website or listen to KYW. Please do not call the school or the convent.



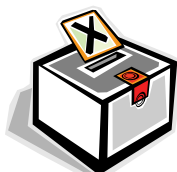

Nominations for Executive Board Positions**

To the Membership:

The Election Committee is now accepting nominations for three NAPA Executive Board positions. Terms of office will begin in May 2010 and end in May 2012. Both self and outside nominations will be accepted. Please do not hesitate to nominate someone whom you feel will benefit the organization. We will contact these individuals, notify them of their nomination and solicit their consent before placing their name on the ballot.

It is expected that all Executive Board members will participate in committee work. Mandatory meetings are held on the first Monday evening of each month. Participation at the two yearly general meetings is also required. The following is a brief summary of the open positions and responsibilities:

**Executive Vice President:** The Executive Vice President serves one year as Vice President and with the Principal's approval, assumes the presidency during the second year of the term. The Executive Vice President assists the President, presides over meetings in the absence of the President, is a voting member of the board and participates on various committees. In addition, the Executive Vice President prepares the monthly Newsletter and notifies Board members of scheduled meetings.

**Corresponding Secretary:** The Corresponding Secretary assists with copying and mailing of all correspondence to the NAPA membership, as well as the ordering of all supplies, stamps, and stationery as needed. This position also includes being responsible for ensuring all major contributors are sent a "thank you" on behalf of NAPA and for sending Mass cards, flowers, etc. as requested by the Board. The Corresponding Secretary is a voting member of the Board and prepares the Family Directory.

**Recording Secretary:** The Recording Secretary prepares and distributes accurate and detailed Board meeting minutes and is a voting member of the Board. In addition, the Recording Secretary maintains a file of meeting agendas, minutes, attendance and voting records, as well as obtaining volunteer sign in forms from event chairpersons.
