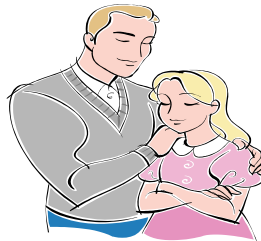
Dr. Michael Bradley will be our guest speaker

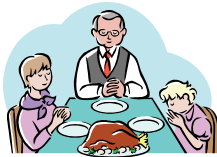
