Thanks so much to everyone who has bought a ticket, sponsored a table or made a contribution – we truly appreciate it!

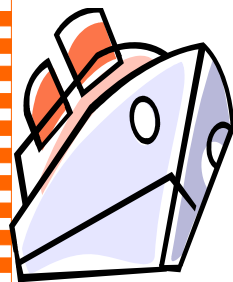
