Checklist for Senior College Application Process

Write your college essay and have it reviewed by the English department or someone you trust.
Create a Common Application Account/ Coalition Account
Complete Common Application Account Matching Process in Naviance to link Common Application and
Naviance
Apply to schools using Common App, Coalition, College website, college portal, etc.
Send SAT/ACT to Colleges using testing website
After you apply, request transcripts
 Inform the college counselor you have applied and give her a copy of the transcript request
form.
 Transcript request fee is \$3.00 for each college
Continue to check your account/emails for each college. Make sure each college application is
complete.
 Ensure that everything is submitted (The application itself, your transcript, your SAT/ACT
scores)
Search for scholarships.
 Utilize NAHS scholarship resources, online search engines, community resources and college
resources.
At the beginning of the Second Semester request a Mid-Year Report.
 Only if the college wants a Mid-Year Report, or if you want a Mid-Year Report sent.
College Acceptances and Scholarship Letters
 Please email the college counselor a copy of all college acceptances, scholarship letters and any
announcements of money for college.
Send your deposit on time (typically May 1stbe sure to check)
After you send your deposit to the school you will attend, withdraw your applications from all other
colleges (you will free up a spot for students who are still waiting)
Let College Counselor know you have committed to a college
 The college counselor will record your attending college and where your final transcript be sent.
 The college counselor will also review and update all of your colleges in Naviance.
Complete and return the Pre-Graduation Form, (which you and your parents must sign)
 Note: When the Graduation Booklet is being prepared, the Pre-Graduation Form and College
Scholarship Letters will be given to the main office.
Final transcripts will be sent by mid-June once transcripts are finalized.
