


From the Office of the President

It was wonderful to see your daughters back at Nazareth this week! I was delighted to see so many smiling faces.

Classes that had summer assignments were posted on the website. As you are aware, not all classes required summer assignments.

Syllabi were distributed for all classes which included course expectations, content, and the grading policy. Your signature will be required to ensure that you are aware of all required for a successful completion of the course. The academic weight of each summer assignment is dependent upon the teacher.

The last day for roster changes (drop/add) will be Thursday, September 2nd. This will allow a student to change a class and perhaps add a new class without an appreciable loss of time. After September 2nd, if a

class is dropped, a designation of W (withdrawal) will appear on the transcript. After October 1st, no class may be dropped.

THIS IS YOUR YEAR TO...

Please encourage your students to read their emails!! Starting next Friday, the seniors will receive an email every week regarding any pertinent post-secondary information that they need such as college visits at Nazareth, application instructions, scholarships, and college opportunities. Please encourage them to check the Class of 2022 College Information Microsoft Team. We update this team as often as we can with relevant information about applications, fee waivers, scholarships, etc.

If your student wants to take the SAT during our SAT School Day on October 13th, please have them [fill out this SAT Sign Up Form](#) by September 10th. The cost is \$55, and you will be provided with a payment form before the SAT. If you believe your family may qualify for an SAT fee waiver, please follow this link to see [Eligibility Requirements](#). If you do meet the requirements, please contact me at amikulski@nazarethacademyhs.org so I can ensure you are billed appropriately. If your student has signed up and they would like to opt out, they have until September 14th to email me with that request.

When your student applies to a college or university, they need to request that their transcript be sent to that particular school. This should be done through the Transcript Request Form. There is a \$3 fee per transcript that is sent. (Example: If your student applies to five colleges, then the fee is \$15.)

I am starting to schedule individual sessions with your students to see where they are in their post-secondary process and to assist them with whatever they may need.

If you have any questions, don't hesitate to contact me.

Class of 2023

The junior class will listen to a presentation given by Ms. Kaloudis on September 2nd to help them start thinking more about their post-secondary options. Students will receive their college counselor assignments this day! Please encourage your students to read their emails! The College Counseling team is going to start sending the junior class weekly emails with any pertinent information they may need for their post-secondary process.

There will be a junior college presentation night in October, so be on the lookout for more information regarding this night coming soon.
