
#### Alpha House Kids Club

## **Safety and Security**

The Attendance and Security Office will be open every school day from the first bell to the dismissal bell. Visitors and vendors will need to provide a driver's license or state-issued ID to enter the building. Visitors will be greeted by a member of the administrative assistant team.

We will also have a member of the Facilities/security staff in the parking lot from 7:15 until the 1<sup>st</sup> bell and again from 20 minutes before the dismissal bell until 2:30.

As in the past, Facilities will perform daily walkthroughs multiple times during the day. Our security cameras are now located on each floor of the school building.
