Nazareth Academy High School is pleased to announce that Ms. Mary Jane Whiteley has been appointed Director of Counseling and will begin on August 30, 2021.

Ms. Whiteley currently serves as the Senior Mental Health Counselor at Holy Redeemer Counseling Center in Huntingdon Valley. Prior to her arrival at Holy Redeemer, Ms. Whiteley led the Counseling Department at the Charter High School for Architecture + Design in Philadelphia as Director of Counseling for eight years, leading a team of counselors and working with students in the areas of emotional, academic and college/career counseling. Before her tenure at CHAD, Ms. Whiteley served as a school counselor at schools in Philadelphia and Bucks County, in addition to working as a therapist, counselor, and social worker.

Ms. Whiteley earned her a B.A. in English from The King's College in Briarcliff Manor, New York, and her M.S. in Counseling from West Chester University. She completed her guidance certification work at Eastern University.

Ms. Whiteley is a Licensed Professional Counselor, Pennsylvania (LPC) and Pennsylvania Level II Certified Secondary School Counselor, as well as a National Certified Counselor (NCC). Ms. Whiteley is also an International Certified Counselor in Co-occurring Disorders (CCDP-D). In 1998, she co-authored an article in *Journal of Substance Abuse Treatment* that addressed assessing the needs of substance abusing women.

Summer/Fall Projects

It has been a very exciting summer at Nazareth.

- The parking lot was repaved, lined and a Belgian Block curb was added along the soccer/lacrosse field.
- The Chapel air handler will be replaced.

- The Performing Arts Center was renovated with a new floor, paint and a new portable stage has been ordered to meet our various performing arts needs.
- The Student Dining Room was painted.

Drop-off and Pick-Up

If you drop your daughter off at Nazareth in the morning, please pull up past the Chapel steps to allow for multiple cars to drop off.

At dismissal, please turn right at the first row, then follow the arrows making a left at the soccer field and driving to the last row making a left. You will then make a left to proceed back to the first row. Parents should not be parked in the aisles with arrows pointing towards the soccer field. Having parents' cars line the perimeter of the lot is a safer process to exit.

Reminder Regarding ID Cards and Lunch Accounts

As a reminder, all students must wear their ID cards on a visible Nazareth Academy High School lanyard. Students must swipe into the building every day.
