COVID Corner

Since last week's weekly update, there have been five positive cases:

- Case 1 Index 0 was not in school during the infectious period
- Case 2 Index 0 had 4 students requiring quarantine
- Case 3 Index 0 had 5 students requiring guarantine
- Case 4 Index 2 had 2 students requiring quarantine.
- Case 5 Index 3 met threshold for quarantining 22 members of the entire cohort for those connected cases

The guidance calls for quarantine and entire class or quarantine when there are three connected cases. We have notified those who are required to quarantine and we have been in communication with the City of Philadelphia.

Please note that there has been a change in the guidance regarding fully vaccinated close contacts and we have notified these individuals.

Asymptomatic fully vaccinated close contacts still do not need to quarantine. However, effective this week, fully vaccinated individuals must test between day 5 and 7 following a known exposure to a confirmed case and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test. (The City of Philadelphia still requires a mask in K-12 schools regardless of vaccination status.)

We are grateful for your attention to the guidance of the City of Philadelphia and the CDC, especially:

- Completing the daily health questionnaire
- Following proper use of masks
- Using the hand sanitizing stations and washing your hands often

PSAT

PSAT scores were released on CollegeBoard, and test books were returned during homeroom. If your student is having trouble with their CollegeBoard account, please have them contact their school and/or college counselor. Freshmen currently in the Study Skills class have made CollegeBoard accounts unless they were absent on that particular class day. All freshmen were emailed instructions on how to make a CollegeBoard account but can certainly meet with their college counselor to create it.

Please watch this VIDEO and follow this LINK from CollegeBoard to help you understand your student's scores. Students will be receiving their PSAT test booklets back in homeroom this week as an aid for viewing questions they answered correctly or incorrectly.

If students have not already, they can link their Khan Academy account to their CollegeBoard account to receive personalized practice for next year's PSAT or upcoming SAT tests. Follow this <u>LINK</u> with your student, select "get started", and follow the prompts to match their accounts.

The **FAFSA** application opened October 1st. Seniors and their families should complete this federal student aid <u>application</u> sooner rather than later for college purposes. Students should check with their colleges to see if there are priority deadlines for FAFSA submission.

The **PA State Grant** program is associated with the FAFSA. There should be more information about PA State grants on the confirmation page you receive after submitting the FAFSA next year. Here is the <u>LINK</u> for the PA State Grant Program if you are interested in seeing if you are eligible to complete this application.

The **CSS Profile** is completed for certain schools in addition to the FAFSA. Here is a link to the <u>Student</u> Guide for the CSS Profile.

Going Merry offers financial aid <u>resources</u> and a way to <u>complete the FAFSA</u> application through their site. Many of your students may have accounts with Going Merry already for scholarship searches. They should be able to use this account to complete the FAFSA if they would rather use Going Merry instead of the FAFSA site.

<u>CollegeBoard</u> offers <u>CLEP exams</u> for students to potentially earn college credit. If a student receives a passing score on an exam, there is a chance that their college may accept it for college credit. You can follow the previous link for more information and follow this <u>LINK</u> to see the colleges and universities that accept CLEP exam scores.
