Career March Madness

So far, your students have learned the descriptions of 16 careers, the education/training required for 8 careers, the projected growth and salary for 4 careers, and the daily tasks and responsibilities for 2 careers. The final 2 careers are Occupational Therapist and Graphic Designer. If you would like to cast

a <u>vote</u> to select the winning career, please do so by March 27th at midnight. The winner will be announced on March 29th!

Class of 2023

Graduation Surveys are due on April 14th! If you or your student have any questions or concerns, please reach out to their specific college counselor.

Students should remember to check housing deadlines for their colleges, look at meal plan options, and accept or reject any financial aid for the colleges they are committing to. They can continue to apply for outside scholarships!

Class of 2024

Students need to ask two teachers for letters of recommendation by April 10th. They should let their college counselor know who agrees to write their letters. They received a form they need to fill out for each teacher via email.

Students have been informed about net price calculators. Every college website should have a net price calculator that you can use to estimate the cost of attending that particular college. You will be prompted to enter financial information in order to receive the estimated cost of attendance. Here is the link to La Salle University's Net Price Calculator as an <u>example</u>.

FAFSA Updates

The FAFSA as we know it is set to change for the next FAFSA cycle. As soon as we learn more information, we will share it with you. Here are a few things we do know:

- In the past, the FAFSA has been available to complete on October 1st. For the next cycle, the FAFSA may be available as late as December 2023 or January 1, 2024.
- The application is being reduced from 130 questions to 30 questions.
- The IRS Data Retrieval tool will be required.
- The # of students in college question will be removed from the calculation of aid.
