- Thank you for your communication regarding COVID positive cases and those exposed who need
 to quarantine. These students are entitled to remote learning. I notify all teachers as quickly as
 possible.
- If your daughter needs assistance in any class, she should speak to her teacher immediately for help. Nazareth Academy also offers peer tutoring through National Honor Society (all subjects except mathematics) and *Mu Alpha Theta* (mathematics).
- Deficiency Reports will be mailed home on September 28. They need to be signed and brought
 back to school with your daughter and returned to the issuing teacher by October 5. I see all
 students who receive these reports in my office. Please note that our meetings are pastoral and
 not punitive. Together, we seek to find a solution to remediate a particular grade.
- Honors and GPA are calculated on the semester and not mid-term grades.
- The close of the Mid-Fall marking period is Friday, October 8.

The PSAT is taking place on October 13th for all freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. Reminder: Students should bring their calculator, #2 pencils (not mechanical), water, and a snack on this day.

Students received a Student Guide in their homerooms to help them prepare for the PSAT.
