
### **Title One Survey**

Under the *Every Student Succeeds Act*, Nazareth Academy High School and our students are eligible to receive Title One funding from the federal government. To acquire these funds, we must have an accurate count of students and the income level for their families. In order to gather this information, a survey was recently mailed home to each family living in Pennsylvania. Even if you suspect that your income level exceeds the requirement, please still submit the survey. We want to submit a survey from every family. I want to assure you your privacy will be protected and no names are required on this family survey form that are sent to each district. *Only* the address and grade levels are provided to the school districts so its staff can determine the funding for the Title I program for the eligible students. Thank you to those who have already submitted their forms and if you have yet to do so, completed forms are due to the Main Office this week, by Friday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Thank you so much.

We can't believe graduation is so close now! We are excited for your students, and we have enjoyed hearing about where they are committing to college.

Please encourage your students to continue sending in acceptance, scholarship, and financial aid letters. Graduation surveys will be sent out by mid-March.

#### **Class of 2024**

On Tuesday March 7<sup>th</sup>, Brad Simon from Saint Joseph's University will be presenting to the junior class about the college essay and activities resume. He will be presenting similar information to parents and guardians at the NAPA meeting on March 7<sup>th</sup> as well.

What your students can be focusing on now for the college process:

- Ask 2 teachers for letters of recommendation by April 10th. They should complete the teach rec questionnaire that was emailed to them for each teacher they ask.
- Conduct college, major, and career searches using sites like Naviance, College Board, [Find the School that Fits You Best - Niche](#), & [CollegeVine](#).
- Look through college websites and ask admissions representatives questions through email or phone calls.
- Set up college visits/tours.
- Reach out to professionals in their fields of interest to interview them or shadow them.
- Look for volunteer opportunities in their fields of interest.
- Start applying for scholarships that they may be eligible for on sites like [Scholarships for College: Find and Apply Online for Free | Going Merry](#), [Scholarships.com Free College Scholarships Search for High School and College Students 2022-2023 Financial Aid Grants Scholarships for College Find and Apply Online for Free](#), and [Browse Scholarships in the Student Hub - Scholarship America](#).
- Choose if/when they want to take the SAT or ACT. Use resources like Khan Academy, Nazareth's prep classes, Magoosh, Revolution Prep, Kaplan, and The Princeton Review to study.
