#### **Advanced Placement Testing**

Remote AP testing will be conducted at a later administration.

#### SAT Tuesday April 27th

Students who are registered for the SAT on Tuesday April 27<sup>th</sup> must report to the gym no later than 7:35AM. Students are permitted to go home after the SAT is completed around 12:00PM-12:30PM. If a student needs to wait for school district bussing, they should bring a lunch to eat after the SAT. After eating, they will report to their 4th block class.
